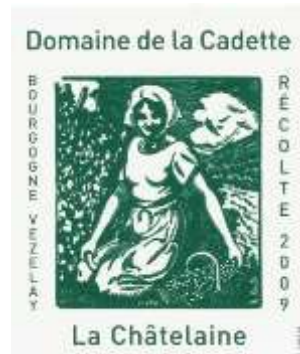


# Domaine de la Cadette

Wine	Domaine de la Cadette Bourgogne Vézelay La Châtelaine 2011
Winemaker	Jean and Catherine Montanet
Appellation	Bourgogne Vézelay
Location	Domaine de la Cadette is located in the village of St Père which lies north east of Dijon in the region known as Vézelay.
Cuvée	La Châtelaine
Red/White/Rose	White
Year	2011
Grape varieties	The La Châtelaine is made from 100% Chardonnay.
Alcohol	12.5%
Viticulture	Certified organic by Ecocert
Terroir	Clay over Kimmeridgean limestone (the same limestone as that found in Sancerre).
Wine-making	The wine comes from grapes from the vineyards on the pretty south-facing slopes of the Vézelay hills. The grapes are harvested by hand and then fermented naturally in vats (80%) and old barrels (20%). This is a beautifully-textured wine, showing that white wines of considerable elegance can be produced in this region.
Notes	La Châtelaine is one of Domaine de la Cadette's best cuvées made from the only permitted grape variety in the Bourgogne Vézelay appellation, Chardonnay.
