Appellation	Bourgogne
Location	Domaine de la Cadette is located in the village of St Père which lies north east of Dijon in the region known as Vézelay.
Cuvée	L'Ermitage
Red/White/Rose	Red
Year	2011
Grape varieties	The l'Ermitage is made from 80% Pinot Noir and 20% of the rare César grape.
Alcohol	11.5%
Viticulture	Certified organic by Ecocert
Terroir	Clay over Kimmeridgian limestone. The vines grow on a very steep south-facing slope, in the rural district of Vézelay at a place called l'Ermitage after which the wine is named.
Wine-making	This wine is made primarily from Pinot Noir (80%), but it also has 20% of the rare César grape that is permitted in the Yonne region of Burgundy. This grape has been grown in this area since Roman times (hence the name).
Notes	This is a beautiful, savoury Burgundy with a lingering, dry finish and with a hint of the exotic from the use of the César grape.



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
