Grape variety	20% Chardonnay and 80% Sauvignon Blanc from vines that are 25 years old
Alcohol	13.5%
Terroir	Limestone and clay
Viticulture	Certified organic by Ecocert and biodynamic by Biodyvin
Wine-making	All grapes are picked by hand. Low yields of around 40 hectolitres per hectare. The grapes are allowed to ferment slowly for up to 2 months. One third of the wine is fermented in large 500 litre wooden 'fûts'. The Sauvignon Blanc undergoes complete malolactic fermentation.
Notes	This is an elegant wine with the small quantity of Chardonnay adding both complexity and longevity to the wine. There is a tiny bit of residual sugar that (2 grams per litre) that rounds out the wine on the palate and makes it a perfect wine to accompany food such as scallops or poached chicken.
