| Terroir        | Limestone and clay formed from Rauracian carbonates (Rauracian is a division of the Oxfordian stage of the late Jurassic) that form the platforms of the Hautes Cotes de Nuits.                               |
| Viticulture    | The vineyards which are near the village of Villers-La-Faye, have not been sprayed or chemically fertilised. The vines are lightly pruned but allowed to grow very long. The grapes have been picked by hand. |
| Wine-making    | The fermentation has been carried out only with natural yeasts and no additives apart from tiny amount of sulphur have been made.   |

Notes

The Black Pinot is a low alcohol (only 11%), lightly coloured, slightly funky, deeply flavoured Pinot Noir of a style that we remember from long ago when we loved Burgundy wines.

Try this with foods such as lamb dishes such as lamb navarin or chicken braised with tomatoes. Due to the low alcohol it would also be fine with charcuterie such as rabbit terrine or pork terrine.
