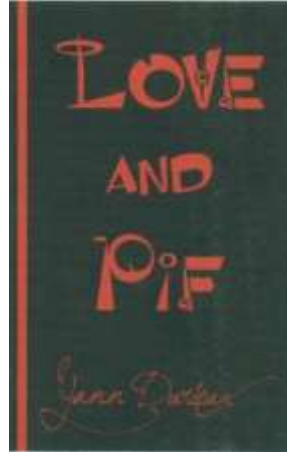


## Yann Durieux

Grape variety	1000% Aligoté
Alcohol	11%
Terroir	Limestone and clay formed from Rauracian carbonates (Rauracian is a division of the Oxfordian stage of the late Jurassic) that form the platforms of the Hautes Cotes de Nuits.
Viticulture	The vineyards which are near the village of Villers-La-Faye, have not been sprayed or chemically fertilised. The vines are lightly pruned but allowed to grow very long. The grapes have been picked by hand.
Wine-making	The fermentation has been carried out only with natural yeasts and no additives apart from tiny amount of sulphur have been made.

Notes

The Love and Pif is a low alcohol (only 11%), wine but exhibits amazing complexity. This is a good example of what happens when Aligoté is allowed to thrive in really good terroir. Yann’s vineyard is quite close to the vineyards established by Domaine Romanee Conti in the Hautes Cotes de Nuits where they have purchased vineyards and are intending to release wines under that domaine’s label, such is their faith in the terroir of this area.
